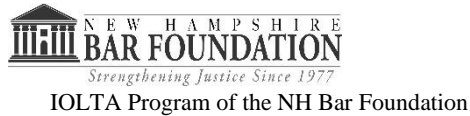

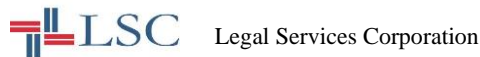

Free civil legal services are available to people in New Hampshire with income and assets below certain limits.

# 603 Legal Aid and New Hampshire Legal Assistance

Working together, we provide legal services in civil (not criminal) matters for people with low income. Services include information and resources; assistance to people representing themselves; advice and counsel; and representation by staff attorneys and volunteer attorneys in all of New Hampshire's courts. Here are some of the civil case types we handle:

**Housing/utilities** - evictions, foreclosures, electricity shutoffs

**Public benefits** - Medicaid, TANF, SNAP, disability benefits

**Domestic violence** - orders of protection

**Family law** - divorce, child support

**Consumer** - debt collection, bankruptcy

**Youth law** - school discipline, special education

**Aging** - nursing home discharges, financial exploitation
